## LICENSE ACQUISITION PROCESS FOR CLIENTS REVOKED, SUSPENDED OR CANCELLED FROM COMPACT MEMBER STATES

- 1. Set up local mailing address, obtain proofs of address, birth certificate with a raised seal, Social Security and current ID card from another state.
- 2. Go to a state DMV office to apply for the license, take written test, inform clerk of the hold, purchase a Colorado state ID, and obtain a denial notice.
- 3. Set appointment in office or by phone, provide us with the denial notice, sign fee agreement and pay initial \$600 retainer.
- 4. We get a DMV case number assigned and file the appeal.
- 5. We coordinate schedules and set a date/time for DMV hearing in 6-8 weeks. When you receive the DMV letter confirming the hearing, send a hard copy to our office for the file. You gather treatment documents and driving history.
- 6. Pay second \$600 10 days before hearing.
- 7. We attend DMV hearing together.
- 8. If the Hearing Officer finds that you meet the qualifications, he enters notes/ order for issuance of a license in spite of the hold and sets conditions to be met, depending on the individual situation.

- 9. Make arrangements to comply with conditions of license issuance (interlock installation, obtain SR-22, alcohol classes, etc.)
- 10. Go to state licensing office to retake the written test and inform DMV clerk about the Hearing Officer's computer notes.
- 11. Take driving test and pass.
- 12. Return to DMV to have paper interlock operator's license issued.
- 13. DMV mails driver's license card to Colorado address.
